**Dominion Valley Country Club by Toll Brothers  
Hosts Official Dedication Ceremony  
of the Silver Lake Property**

Dominion Valley Country Club by Toll Brothers, a luxury master planned golf community in Haymarket, will be dedicating the magnificent 318-acre Silver Lake property to the Prince William County Board of Supervisors. This spectacular gift is being made in accordance with proffers as agreed to between the Prince William County Board of Supervisors and Toll Brothers.

The property, once a private campground and former stone quarry, is now being conveyed in its entirety to Prince William County at no charge to be put into various public uses, including a 40-acre middle school site and a 45-acre therapeutic horse riding center, with the remaining 233 acres to be used for parks and recreation purposes.

Prince William County Board of Supervisors and Planning Commission, Prince William School Board members, members of the Bull Run Mountain conservatory group, Silver Lake supporters, Prince William County Park Authority, Rainbow Riding Center, and Toll Brothers representatives expected to attend.
